POPSICLE STICK SNOWFLAKES

I want to share with you a craft to bring a little cheer and sparkle to your home during this winter.

SUPPLIES:

-Popsicle Stick (Any size) -Hot Glue Gun (Or any type of glue, it just will take longer to set) -Ribbon or string -Decorative items (Paint, buttons, gems, ect.)



INSTRUCTIONS:

Step 1) On a flat surface take your popsicle sticks and place them in any shape you would like your snowflake to be. To the right are a couple ideas for inspiration. Feel free to cut the sticks if you desire.

Step 2) Use a dot of hot glue to connect the sticks anywhere they touch. You can test if you have made all connections by gently lifting your snowflake off the table.

Step 3) Create a loop with your ribbon or string. The loop can be any size, but for an ornament I would make it at least 1.5 inches long. Once the loop is tied, use your hot glue to attach it to the back top most point of the snowflake.

Step 4) Now its time to decorate it! This is really where you can let your imagination go wild. Paint, sparkles, and buttons are few of my favorite things to add to my snowflakes to give it a bit of the holiday flair.

Step 5) Admire your work!







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
